9. Facilities (Laboratory/ Library/ Hostel):

The college has adequate facilities and resources to conduct curricular and cocurricular activities. All the students have easy access to the available learning resources. Keeping in view the role and impact of technological advancements on higher education, new infrastructure is created, and existing is upgraded to give a new direction to teaching teaching-learning process during the post-accreditation period. A well-built campus and the availability of good infrastructural facilities of the college are its strengths in imparting qualitative education to the students. The Institution has a campus of 29995 sq mtr with 7512sq mtr built area. We have 21 spacious classrooms, 22 UG/PG well-equipped laboratories, 6 ICT-enabled classrooms, 2 wellfurnished conference/seminar halls/auditoriums with LCD projectors and ICT facilities with altogether seating provision of 300. Renovation/reconstruction work of Wardens accommodation, waiting rooms and the second floor of the girls' hostel is also carried out recently. The administrative office and library is upgraded and automated. The majority of this infrastructure is either upgraded, renovated or reconstructed in the post-accreditation period. Specialized lab and computer labs are extensively used for effective teaching-learning and research. Total 150 computers are

available in the college. The college has appointed a Computer expert for upkeep and maintenance of computers and sensitive equipment. All departments are well connected with PC and Broadband Internet connection with Wi-Fi facility. The library is computerized and the internet facility is made available free of cost to all students. A total 87946 books are available in the library. There are two separate reading rooms for male and female students and one reading room for research scholars in the central library. The central library, along with main office and few departments are provided with full battery back-up in period of electricity cut. The indoor game facilities are improved and outdoor game facilities are made available in the extended Dnyan Pandhari campus. A modern gymnasium and ample parking zone is made available at the underground space of the new building. Facilities like staff-room, canteen, center, group insurance are made available. To make the campus eco-friendly, a 45KW solar unit is commissioned. RO system for pure water and one generator also are provided. Along with well-equipped Departments, the college has separate well-furnished offices for NSS, NCC, NAAC/IQAC, YCMOU Center and two Vice-Principals. These infrastructural developments are carried by the Management to meet the needs of students and teachers community during the post-accreditation period.

10. Research and Development:

The institution has created an ecosystem for innovations through the Research & Development Committee. The college has well-equipped laboratories for research and development. The Research & Development Committee provides research inputs to students and encourages them in doing research activities of prescribed syllabi and in the field of their interest. As per the suggestions given by the Research & Development Committee, IQAC took the initiative to organize a workshop and motivate all the departments to conduct interactive skill-based sessions of experts from various fields. Various departments organized workshops of their respective disciplines. The Research & Development committee encouraged students to participate in Research Programmes organized at zonal and University level. Thus, the institution provides knowledge inputs to the students through research, skill-based and innovative activities so as to prepare them for different professions in the future.

11. Promotion of Research and Innovation

IQAC has taken the necessary steps to promote research culture among the staff and students. The college has a research committee for the promotion of research. As a result of the consistent efforts of the institute the number and quality of research

activities in the institution has gone up significantly. During the last five years, the institution organized 30 workshops/invited talks/seminars/webinars on recent topics of UG and PG Programme by various departments. 05 Minor Research Projects funded by S.R.T.M. University, Nanded & UGC. More than 347 research papers have been published in National and International Journals. The number of books/chapters in edited books and research papers published in conference proceedings has gone up to 124. Total 28 teachers have completed their Ph.D. and 04 teachers have registered for Ph.D. The students prepared and submitted the research projects for their UG and PG courses.

12. Sports and Culture Facilities for cultural activities

12.1. Cultural Facilities

There is an air-conditioned Auditorium made available for cultural activities with enough seating for 200 people. It is equipped with an LCD projector, and a sound system and a changing room for various cultural events and initiatives. The purpose of the cultural committee that has been established is to encourage and direct student participation in cultural activities. The Cultural Committee is responsible for organizing a variety of activities that take place throughout the year including annual gathering. At the youth festival organized by S.R.T.M. University, many students of the college represented for the institution and won several prizes till date. The college provides students with access to essential instruments such as harmoniums, tanpuras, mrudungs, dholakis, and tablas.

12.2 Facilities for Sports and Games

The institution provides a large playground at our extended campus "Dnyanpandhari" Awalkondha road Udgir, where students can play and practise various sports such as cricket, football, volleyball, kabaddi, long jump, high jump, throwing disc, shot-put and javelin throw. College students compete in many sports tournaments organised by the university and other organisations. The college has ample equipment for all indoor and outdoor games.

12.3 Gymnasium

There is a gymnasium in addition to sport equipments. For those who want to get in shape, there is workout equipment available, including stationary bikes and treadmills. There is a Gymnasium Committee which looks for the management and maintenance of the gym facilities. Every year, students take part in athletic contests on both the intercollegiate and national levels.
