Students Feedback:

Excellent- (235) 67.91%,

Good- (49) 14.16 %


Satisfactory- (44) 12.7 %,

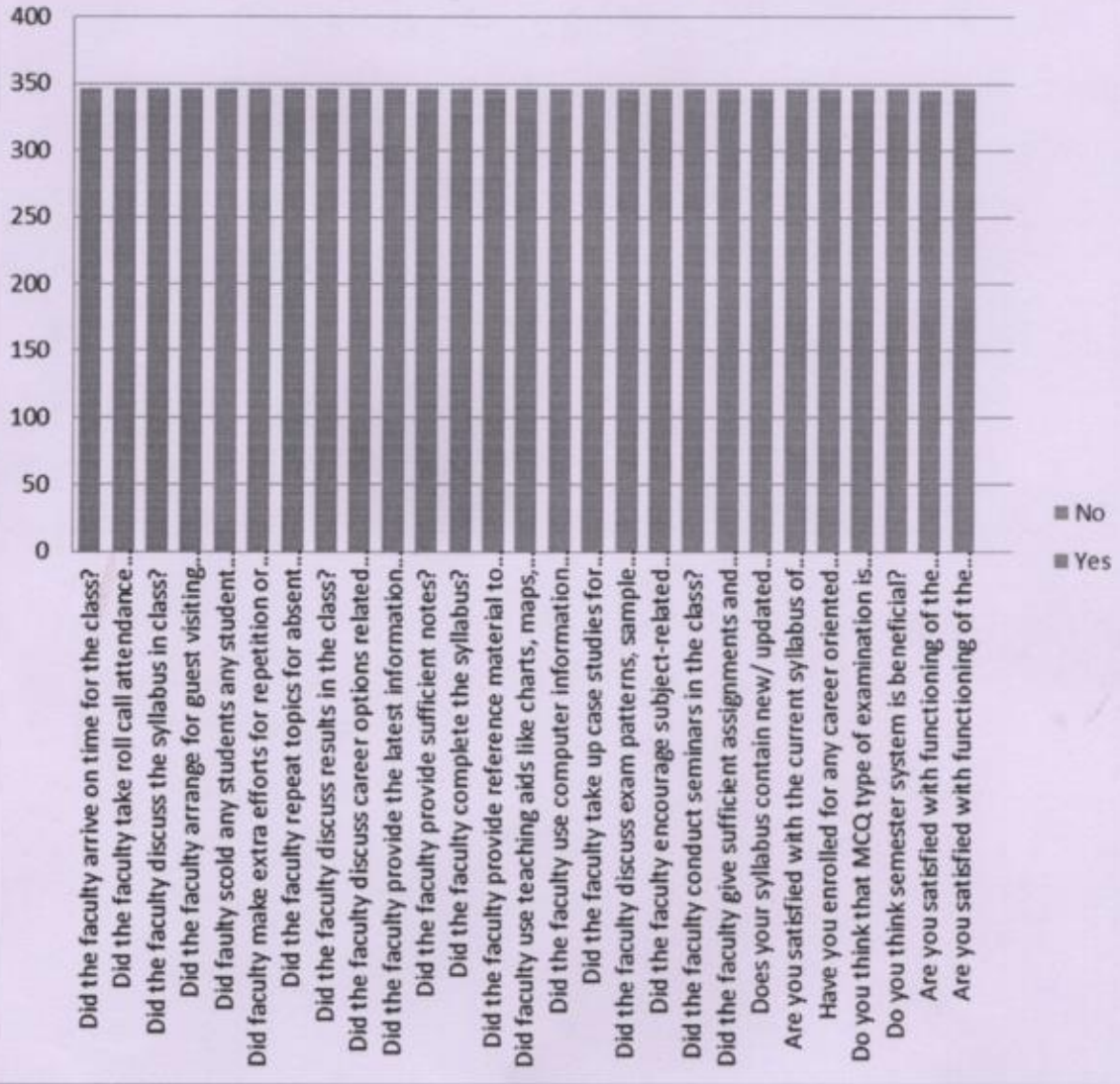

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Analysis of Alumni feedback during academic year 2022-23

Our alumni are valuable to us they provide the inputs regarding improvement in facilities and the employability of our students. We appeal to our alumni to provide their sincere feedback on the curriculum. We have received a total of **106** alumni feedback about the college, the library, and the relevance of the syllabus designed by the parent university. After analysis of the responses, it is found that the maximum number of respondents are satisfied.

The question was asked to the respondents regarding their overall impression of the college and it was found that 21 (19.81 %) of respondents said that overall college is excellent, 56 (52.8 %) good, 17 (16.03 %) satisfactory, 10 (9.43%) average and 2(1.88%) respondents feel there is need of improvement. Most of the alumni are satisfied with the course content and the syllabus was helpful in placement after graduation/post-graduation. Most of the respondents are happy with computer laboratories, library, seminars, guest lectures and workshops conducted, projects and field visits. They feel that the institution supports higher learning and the curriculum provided in the college caters to the entrepreneurial skills of the students.


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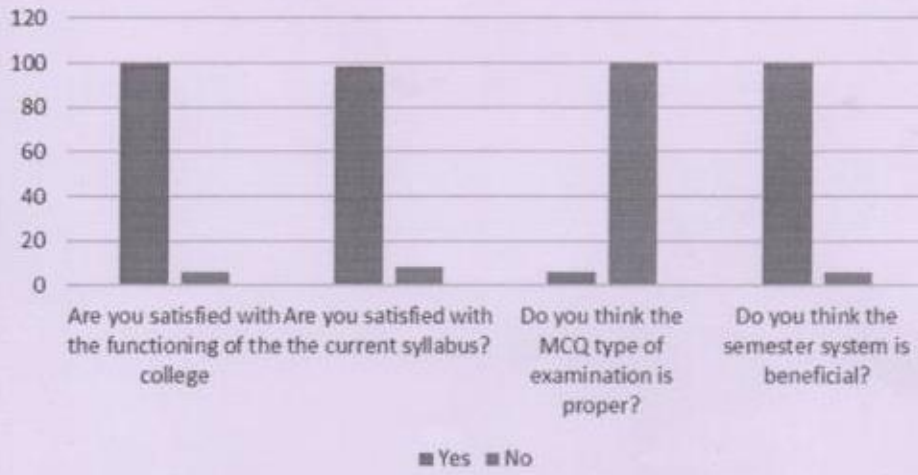




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ANALYSIS OF EMPLOYER FEEDBACK -2022-23

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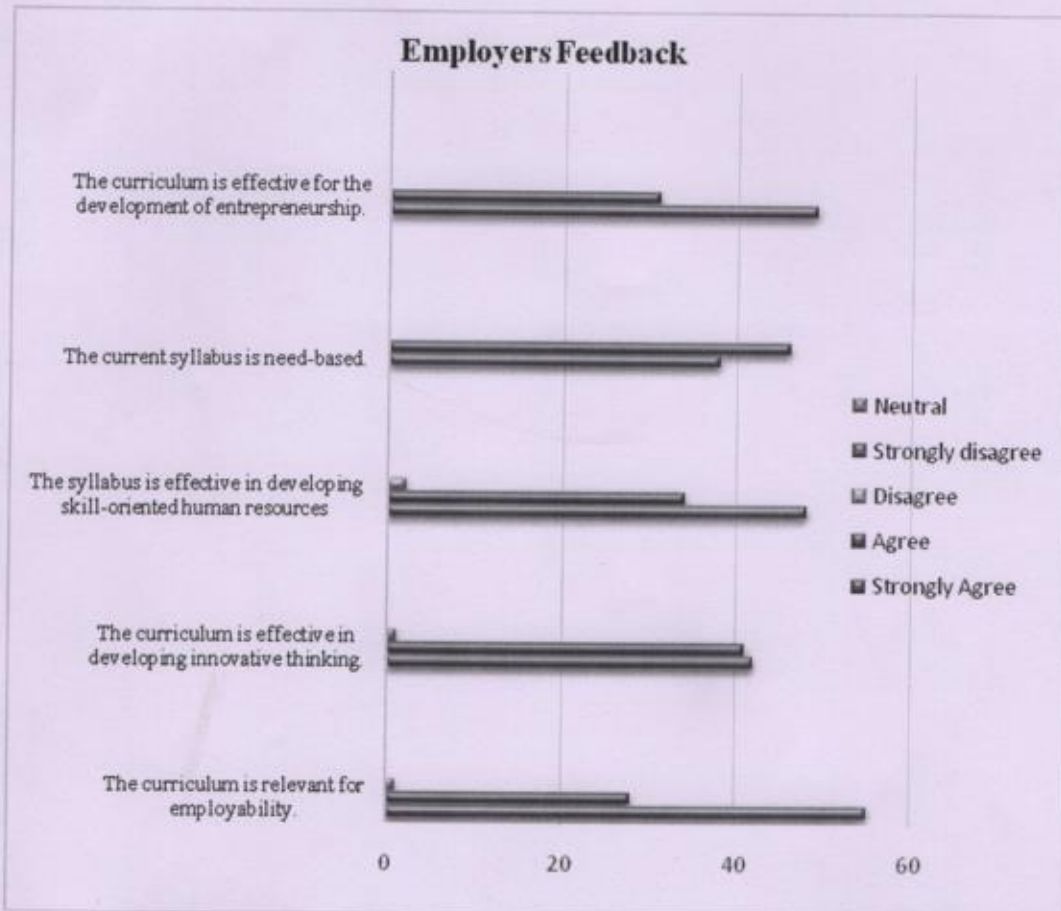

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


